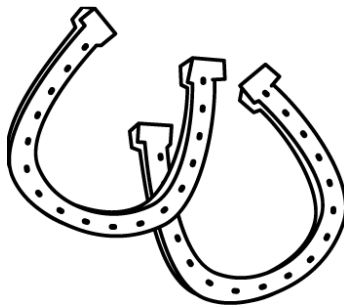

## Notes for Competitors

- A. Entries are due no later than **August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010**. There will be a late entry fee of \$10.00 after this date.
- B. Entries will **NOT** be accepted on the day of the show.
- C. There should be one entry form filled out for each horse/rider combination.
- D. Entry fees will be \$6.00 per class for up to 6 classes or \$40.00 for the two days.
- E. There will be a \$5.00 number fee. This fee will be returned when you return your ring number.
- F. Horses may arrive on site **Wednesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>** after 6:00pm. There will be no charge to the competitors for stabling.
- G. The **Youth** division is open to all competitors 18 years of age and under.
- H. Open stake classes are open to all competitors at the show. There is an entry fee of \$10.00 to enter each stake class.
- I. Versatility is a class that combines pleasure driving, halter and hunter. The class will begin with pleasure driving, following which the competitor has 2 minutes to unhitch their horse and prepare for the halter portion. The competitors will then be asked to take to hunter jumps.
- J. Competitors may enter Class 1 (Broodmare with foal at side) or Class 3 (Open Mare). Cross entries will not be allowed for these classes.
- K. Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Prizes will be awarded as follows:
  - 1. Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Mare or Filly
    - Top 2 places from Class 1 (Broodmare with foal at side) or Class 3 (Open Mare/Filly) qualify for the Grand Champion Mare or Filly Class.
  - 2. Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Stallion or Gelding
    - Top 2 places from Class 4 (Open Gelding) and Class 5 (Open Stallion) qualify for the Grand Champion Stallion or Gelding Class
  - 3. Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Youth
    - Points will be added from Class 9 (Youth Obstacle in Hand), Class 11 (Youth Pleasure Driving), Class 13 (Youth Roadster) and Class 17 (Youth Obstacle Driving) to determine Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Youth.
  - 4. Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Adult
    - Points will be added from Class 8 (Adult Obstacle in Hand), Class 10 (Adult Pleasure Driving), Class 12 (Adult Roadster) and Class 16 (Adult Obstacle Driving) to determine Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Adult.
  - 5. Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Youth Games
    - Points will be added from Class 15 (Youth Hunter), Class 22 (Youth Jumper), Class 25 (Youth Poles) and Class 27 (Youth Barrels) to determine Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Youth Games.
  - 6. Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Adult Games
    - Points will be added from Class 14 (Adult Hunter), Class 21 (Adult Jumper), Class 24 (Adult Poles) and Class 26 (Adult Barrels) to determine Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Adult Games.

- L. NO PETS ARE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS. Assistance dogs in harness are welcome.
- M. Upon departure, all stalls must be cleaned of manure and bedding and be transported to the dumpster. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of all prize money.
- N. Admission to the exhibition is \$8 per day for adults, \$4 per day for children ages 6-12 years and children under 6 are free. Passes for the entire week are available for \$20 if purchased before July 31<sup>st</sup>. Passes will be \$25 after this date. If you would like to purchase a \$20 pass, please fill out the form at the bottom of this page and include it and your payment with your entry.
